Issues searched on the net



1. How much water does your country have?

- 3328 m³ flows in Slovak rivers,
- 12% of this amount of water springs in Slovakia
- 54 huge water dams



2. *How much of it does your country use economically?*

- 340 000m³ water per a month is consumed in Priedvīdza District,
- in industry it is 32 000m³ water,
- in agriculture 9 000 m³
- in other fields it is 65 000m³.
- it is only 50% of water used in industry than before.



3. How much is the amount of water available per a person?

Only 107 liters of drinkable water are drunk by an inhabitant a year. People prefer mineral water.



4. Will water shortage be a problem for your country in the future (with population growth if there is)?

Water is the only strategic material which Slovakia has enough for the future. The water means a lot for the future of Slovakia.



5. Are there any precautions taken or plans made by the government?

The Ministry of the Environment pursues the preliminary work to be able to make decision about exporting Slovak water abroad in the future. But at the same time in 20 or 30 years we will have had to handle with it very reasonably, to use it wisely, to save it and protect it for future generations.

6. *How much water is used for irrigation in agriculture?*



Agricultural land in the Slovak Republic covers 24 442 km² from all the area of 49 000 km².

- Just 3100 km² of agricultural land is irrigated what accounts for 12,68%.**
- That is the land near the rivers, brooks and lakes.**



7. How much ground water and underground water does your country have?

In Priedvīdza District we have 109-112 water sources



***8. Is waste water in your country purified?
How much percent is purified?***

- more than 50% rainfall water is trapped and drained into sewagewater.
- almost 80% of waste water is purified in sewage treatment plants.

9. *Does your country make use of water from rain? (Is it stored?)*



Rain water is used by common people who keep it in a capacious tanks. It is used :

- to water the gardens - flowers, lawns and plants
- to flush the toilets
- to wash garden furniture, cars and others
- the rain water is also gathered in the reseirvors
